Teachers will use the grants to buy teacher reference books and students readings in 2022-2023. As the border shutdown between HKSAR and China, the school can't arrange Mainland interflow activities or study tours relating to the CSD curriculum in 2021-2022. The school has assigned HK local visit for S4 students in summer holiday to help them to understand, study and explore different topics from multiple perspectives about the situations of Hong Kong and China relating to the CSD curriculum. Students submitted a report and reflection after their visit. It is suggested to arrange local HK tours for S4 students to help them study and explore the local culture in HK. The border shutdown continues affected the planning of Mainland study tours in 2022-2023.
